

Trying to figure out the **DRESS CODE**? Use these guidelines to help you make your choices.

ALWAYS Appropriate

Collared polo or dress shirt
OR WCA T-shirt (W/F only)

Solid-colored slacks that are either blue, black, tan, or gray – no cargo pockets

Solid-colored shorts no more than 2" above the knee.
Same colors as pants

Solid colored sweater or sweatshirt, wear collared shirt beneath

Shoes that cover the foot and are safe for activities

Why Do We Have a Dress Code?

A dress code aims to ensure the students are dressed appropriately for school, and that they will not be distracted by another student's attire. It allows students to attend school without the pressure of having to dress in expensive clothing to "keep up" and helps to create an identity with the school.

How Can A Dress Code Benefit You?

Makes choosing your clothes easier

Reduces distractions

Eliminates distinctions between haves/have nots

Provides an opportunity to conquer yourself

Helpful Hints:

Keep an appropriate outfit in your locker in case you are asked to change. Determine to honor the agreement you made when signing to attend WCA.

Never Appropriate

Clothing with logos other than WCA logo

Hoods up or hats on inside the building, jackets worn in class, yoga/sweatpants

Sleeveless shirts or dresses, leggings worn without a dress or skirt covering

Immodest clothing that is too short, too tight, too revealing, or that contains holes, rips, tears

Unnatural hair colors, extreme hairstyles

Occasionally, the school will allow variations to the dress code for one reason or another. Even on those days modesty is in order, and any variance to the traditional dress code must fall within the guidelines for the exceptions. For example, even if wearing jerseys to show support for your favorite team is allowed, it is still not okay to wear jeans with holes in them.
